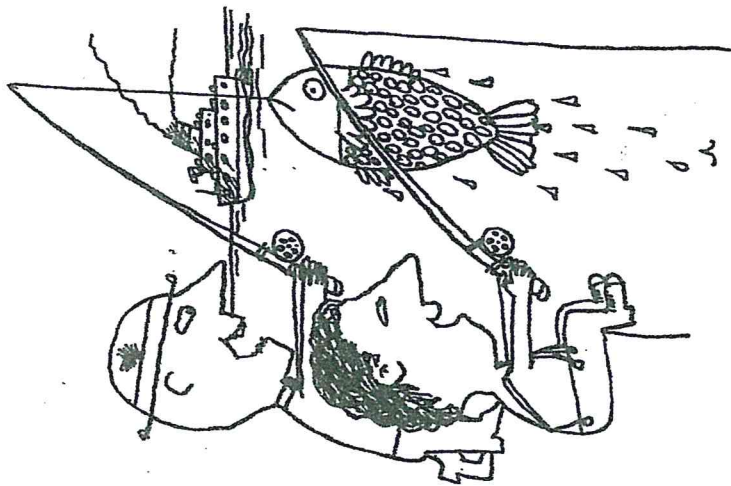


Fishing
